Contributor owns, and has sufficient rights to contribute, all source code and related material intended to be compiled or integrated with the source code for the wxWindows open source product which Contributor has (a) ever delivered, including without limitation that generally described in Exhibit A attached hereto; or (b) will ever deliver, and the wxWindows Software Foundation (the "Foundation") accepts (the "Contribution"), for incorporation into the technology made available through the wxWindows open source project.

2. Contributor hereby assigns to the Foundation all right, title and interest in all past, present and future Contributions, including without limitation ownership in all worldwide common law and statutory rights associated with the copyrights, copyright application, copyright registration and moral rights in the Contribution, together with the right to secure renewals, reissues and extensions of such copyrights, to the extent allowable under applicable local laws and copyright conventions. Contributor agrees that this Copyright Assignment may be submitted by the Foundation to register a copyright in the Contribution.

3. Contributor is legally entitled to grant the above assignment and agrees not to provide any Contribution that violates any law or breaches any contract.

4. The Foundation hereby grants Contributor a non-exclusive, irrevocable, world-wide, no-charge transferable license to use, modify, prepare derivative works of, distribute and sublicense the Contribution as Contributor wishes.

5. The Foundation hereby agrees to distribute the Contribution under terms that both (a) comply with the Debian Free Software Guidelines (DFSG), either the version effective as of Sept. 2003 or, at the choice of the Foundation, a version which becomes effective later (the "DFSG"), or the Open Source Definition, either v 1.9 or, at the choice of the Foundation, a later version ("OSD"); and (b) require that all subsequent distribution of the Contribution and changes to the Contribution be made under terms that comply with either the DFSG or the OSD. (The "BSD" license is an example of a license that fulfils condition (a) but not condition (b) above; therefore the Foundation will not distribute the Contribution under a BSD-style license.) This requirement relating to subsequent distribution must apply to the changes of the Contribution itself, but need not apply to code with which the Contribution or modified Contribution may be combined. (The "Lesser GNU Public License" is an example of a license that applies to the Contribution itself, and may therefore be used by the Foundation.) The requirements of compliance with the DFSG and the OSD shall be waived in the event that significant legal disputes develop regarding the DFSG or the OSD.
