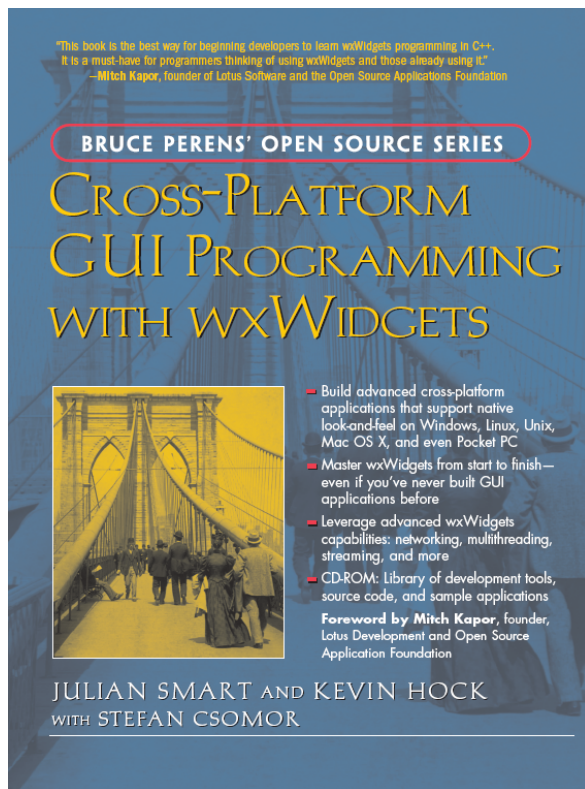


Cross-Platform GUI Programming with wxWidgets
